With a brilliant nose of ripe ruby red grapefruit, this medium-bodied and pleasantly rounded wine has a lively, yet unobtrusive texture. A light, yet solidly fruity Rosé with a palate full of well-defined flavors like white raspberry, soft hibiscus and strawberry rhubarb.
